Massachusetts climate derives itself from it's location in New England at the northeast part of the United States. This gives it some of the most unique climate in the entire country. Enjoying each of the four distinct seasons, the weather in Massachusetts moves from the warm sun of summer to cold, snowy winters; the overall pattern described as a "humid continental climate."

The Massachusetts climate of typical summer weather averages a high of 80°F with comfortable nights of 60-65°F. Winter brings temperatures that hover right around the freezing mark of 32°F, give or take five degrees.*
